- If the applicant and the applicant's parents have a foreign citizenship before the applicant enrolls in a high school curriculum in Korea, the applicant will be recognized as a foreign national.
- If the applicant is supported by only one of the parents, the nationality of the parent will be recognized for the eligibility for assistance. However, this must be confirmed by a government issued documentation.

- 1) All documents must be submitted in original form, and submitted documents will not be returned under any circumstances.
- 2) All documents must be submitted by postal mail.
- 3) All documents must be submitted by the deadline stated in the admission guidelines, based on Korean Standard Time (KST).
- 4) All documents must be prepared in Korean or English. If they are in another language, a notarized Korean or English translation must be submitted.
- 5) The applicant is responsible for any disadvantages caused by incorrect or incomplete information on the application form or failure to respond to communications from the university.
- 6) Academic documents are only accepted if issued within six months from the start date of the application period.
- 7) Graduation and transcript documents issued by foreign schools **must be notarized with a Korean or English translation**.
- 8) All certificates issued by foreign institutions must be accompanied by an **Apostille Certificate** issued by the designated government authority of the school's country, or a **Consular Confirmation/Verification Certificate** issued by a Korean Embassy or Consulate in that country.
- 9) Applicants for transfer admission must submit supporting documents related to their previous university's graduation requirements, earned credits, semesters completed, and grading system.
- 10) Submission of original documents is required in principle. However, if submission of the originals within the application period is unavoidable, applicants may submit copies temporarily with prior approval from the Office of International Affairs and then submit the originals within the designated period.
- 11) Failure to submit the original documents within the designated period, or any discrepancy between submitted copies and originals, will result in revocation of admission.
- 12) Admission will be revoked if it is found that the applicant has been admitted through fraudulent means (e.g., forged documents, falsified qualifications, proxy testing) either before or after enrollment. In such cases, tuition and fees already paid will not be refunded.
- 13) Applicants expecting to graduate must submit final graduation and transcript certificates within the submission deadline set by the university.
- 14) Failure to submit the final graduation (or completion) documents by the deadline will result in revocation of admission.
- 15) If, due to a country's or institution's academic system, semester-by-semester or yearly transcripts cannot be issued, the Office of International Affairs may request additional documents or evidence.
- 16) Depending on the applicant's case, the Office of International Affairs may adjust the required documents or request additional materials, which must be submitted within the specified deadline.
- 17) Failure to submit required supporting documents on time, resulting in visa issuance delays, may lead to cancellation of admission.
- 18) Only language test scores valid during the application period will be accepted.
